

**VILLAGE OF ANDREW  
BYLAW NO. 2002-02**

**Being a bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 94-14 of the Village of Andrew in the Province of Alberta.**

WHEREAS, Council has adopted The Village of Andrew Traffic Bylaw No 94-14;

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed expedient and in the public interest to amend Traffic Bylaw No. 94-14 to insert sections 515,516,517,518,519 and 520 and to insert penalties for these sections in Schedule "B", Part V – Zones of Operations of Vehicles.

AND WHEREAS under the authority and subject to the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act and the Municipal Government Act, Statutes of Alberta, 1994 Chapter M-26.1 and amendments thereto consolidated on September 1 2000,

NOW THEREFORE; the Council of the Village of Andrew, in the province of Alberta duly assembled does hereby amend Bylaw 94-14 with the insertion of the following clauses as follows:

Stopping Before

Entering the Highway

515. In this section, "street means a street within the meaning The "Public Highways Development Act".

516. A driver about to enter on

1. a primary highway or street from a road, service road, alley or driveway, or

2. an alley or road from a driveway,

shall, unless the intersection of the two roadways is marked with a "yield" sign or a "merge" sign, bring that vehicle to a stop;

3. before entering on the intersecting roadway and at a point no further than 3 metres from the intersecting roadway,

4. if there is a marked crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, immediately before entering the crosswalk, or

5. if there is a marked stop line on the near side of the intersection, at the stop line.

517. Notwithstanding section 516,

1. a driver of a vehicle emerging from an alley or driveway shall stop that vehicle before driving onto a sidewalk crossing and shall yield the right of way to any pedestrian on the sidewalk or sidewalk crossing, and
2. a driver entering an alley or driveway shall yield the right of way to any pedestrian on a sidewalk or sidewalk crossing.

Stop Signs

518. A driver of a vehicle about to enter on any highway that is marked by a “stop” sign shall bring that vehicle to a stop,

1. before entering on the intersecting roadway and at a point no further than 3 metres from the intersecting roadway,
2. if there is a marked crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, immediately before entering on the crosswalk, or
3. if there is a marked stop line on the near side of the intersection, at the stop line.

Proceeding after Stopping 519. When a driver is required to stop pursuant to Section 516 or 517 that driver

1. shall not proceed until the condition of the traffic on the highway being entered on is such that a driver can enter on it in safety, and
2. shall yield the right of way to all traffic approaching on the highway.

Yield Signs

520. A driver of a vehicle about to enter on a highway that is marked by a yield sign need not stop that vehicle before entering but that driver shall yield the right of way to all traffic on the highway being entered on.

That Bylaw 94-14 Schedule "B" , Part V – Zones of Operations of Vehicles be amended to include the following insertion as attached to Bylaw 2002-02:

This Bylaw shall come into effect upon passage thereof.


Read for a first time this 28<sup>th</sup> day of August 2002
