## **Description of Documents**

The Municipal Government Act governs, among other things, how municipalities manage and administer planning and development activities that occur within their communities.

Intermunicipal development Plan (IDP) - The IDP is a joint agreement between the Village of Andrew and Lamont County which outlines a cooperative framework for managing the use and development of lands adjacent to the boundary of Andrew, within Lamont County.

Municipal Development Plan (MDP) - The MDP is a long-range planning policy document which guides future growth and development within the Village.

Area Structure Plans – Area Structure Plans are an important part of the planning process that provides a framework for the subsequent subdivision and development of land.

Land Use Bylaw (LUB) - The LUB regulates the use and development of land in the Village.

Subdivision Control – The Subdivision Authority for the Village of Andrew is Municipal Planning Services Ltd.
