

BYLAW # 2024 - 04

Designated Officer Bylaw

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF ANDREW, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO ESTABLISH THE POSITION OF ASSESSOR AS DESIGNATED OFFICER

WHEREAS Section 284.2 of the Municipal Government Act, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26.1, as amended, requires that an Assessor be appointed as a designated officer.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of section 210 of the Municipal Government Act, the Council may pass a bylaw to establish one or more positions to carry out the powers, duties, and functions of a designated officer.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Andrew in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

TITLE: This Bylaw may be referred to as the "Designated Officer Bylaw" of the Village of Andrew.

1. That the position of Assessor be established as a designated officer for the purpose of assessment as per the Municipal Government Act.
2. Council shall appoint, by resolution, a Municipal Assessor for the Village of Andrew.


That this bylaw is effective upon the date of its third and final reading.
