## Recycling Program

The Andrew blue bag recycle program. Residents are reminded to have your items on the front curb by 7:00 am every Tuesday.

### What CAN I recycle?

- Newsprint and heavy paper inside one blue bag.
- Plastic and tin cans in another blue bag.
- Collapsed and bundled corrugated cardboard (secured under the blue bag(s)/

### Why BLUE BAGS Only?

Blue Bags are made from a recyclable material whereas some types of other bags are not. In addition, the blue color is a visual flag for drivers, letting them know you have recyclables for pickup.

### What should NOT go in blue bags?

- Plastic toys
- Bubble wrap / Plastic film
- Styrofoam
- Un-rinsed food containers
- Diapers
- Electronics or small appliances etc.

# 2024 BUDGET SUMMARY

## Village of Andrew

### 2024 budget changes from 2023:

- New picnic tables
- Upgrades to the campground showers
- Additional audit fees to be up to date with financial reporting
- Consultant/interim CAO services
- Increase to RCMP costs
- Adding 1 streetlight for safety
- Water cc valve repairs
- Addressing drainage concerns
- Logo/promotional project
- Ownership of school building / utilities
- Repairs to Andrew Community Centre (flooding)

2024 total budgeted expenses = \$1,614,764 ( Approximately \$180,000 increase in expenses over 2023)

### Impact to taxes:

The assessment values in the Village of Andrew saw an overall decrease for the 2024 tax year. Administration and Council have worked hard to budget for expenses to meet the needs of the community and still maintain tax bill amounts to as close to 2023 as possible.

Commercial tax rates were increased slightly more than residential rates for 2024. Education property taxes (ASFF) are set out by the province. These amounts are collected by the Village then provided to the province directly. More information about school tax can be found here: <https://www.alberta.ca/education-property-tax>

Residential tax rate: 15.45

Commercial tax rate: 18.24

Average residential tax bill: \$1,806 (2024) / \$1,572.31 (2023)

### Village of Andrew services:

- Water/sewer utility (billing/customer service, maintenance of infrastructure)
- Garbage and recycling
- Access/use of tree dump
- Water truck fill station
- Business licensing
- Support of municipal library
- Support of Lamont County FCSS
- Customer service (photocopying, faxing, communications, tax certificates, etc.)
- Planning and development (development permits, compliance certificates)
- Outdoor maintenance (snow removal, grass cutting, beautification)
- Support of regional fire department
- Recreation (bowling alley, fitness center, tennis/basketball court, walking trail) including partnerships with non-profits such as the Agricultural Society, Community Center Association and Curling Club
- Campgrounds
- Community events (Family Day, Canada Day, Remembrance Day, Christmas)

**2024 capital projects:**

- Curb replacement
  - Sewer line repairs (51 Avenue)
  - Truck fill upgrade
- \*additional projects will be considered by Council if grant funding is secured

**2024 COMBINED ASSESSMENT/ TAX NOTICES**

Notice is hereby given that the combined assessment/tax notices were mailed to all assessed persons in the Village of Andrew on June 3, 2024.

**ASSESSMENT ROLL**

Any person who objects to the assessment values placed upon a property must, within 60 days from the notice of assessment date, **June 11, 2024**, forward a complaint in writing together with a \$100 fee per appeal to the Village of Andrew. The assessment roll can be viewed at the Village Office during office hours.

Reminder: Making a complaint against your assessment does not make you exempt from paying your taxes by the deadline of July 12, 2024.

**TAX PAYMENTS**

2024 taxes are due July 12, 2024. Unpaid taxes are subject to penalties of 10% on September 1, 2024 and January 1, 2025.

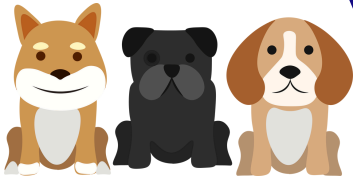

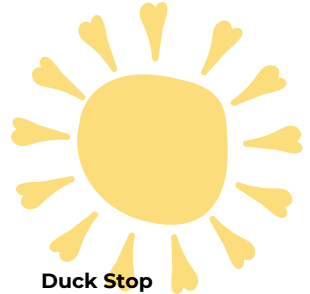
## 2024 Dog Tags are now Available!

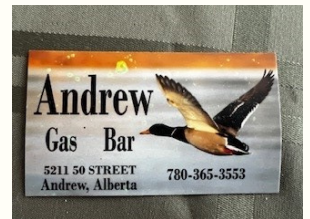
