Council and Administration have been busy working to complete the Municipal Inspection Directives. The Minister of Municipal Affairs ordered the Village to complete 11 Directives relating to several areas of governance and administration.

The Village is happy to report that the Municipal Inspection Directives have now been completed. This includes the passing of the following Bylaws and Policies:

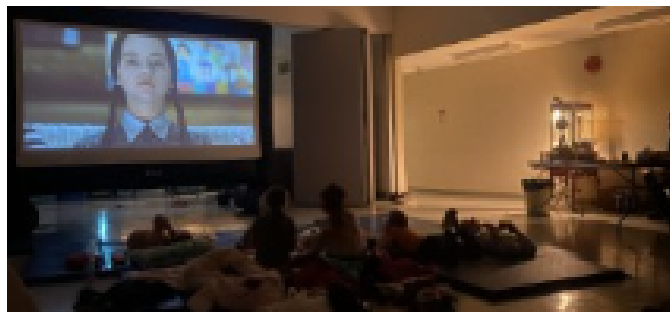


## YARD WASTE COLLECTION HAS ENDED

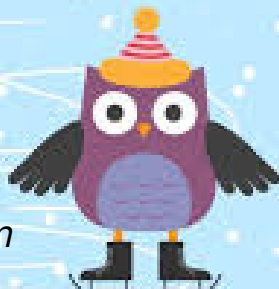

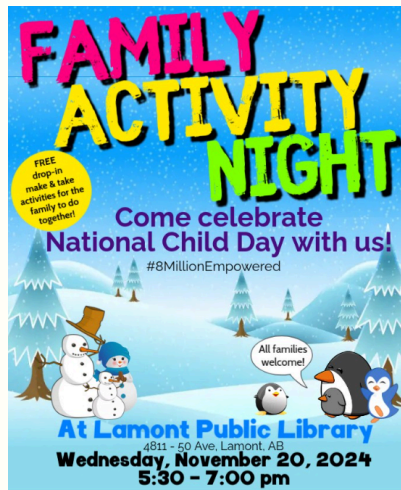
