COUNCIL MEETING UPDATE

-At the March 26, 2025 meeting Council passed a long term borrowing bylaw (\$800,000) to fund sewer line repairs required along 51 Avenue. The project can now be planned including applying for a loan, gathering competitive pricing and setting timelines.

-The Village will participate in the Two Hills Tourism Conference to promote Andrew (non-profits & tourism related organizations are encouraged to contact Kylie (cao@liveinandrew.com) if you wish to team up or provide marketing materials for us to share.

-The Village is sponsoring a hole in the Lamont County Reeve's Golf Tournament in August (\$450 cost).

-Tammy Pickett has resigned from Village Council, effective March 20, 2025. Merwin Haight was appointed as Deputy Mayor to fill the vacancy.

-The Village will work with the Andrew Rural Academy Foundation to proceed with the sale of the school building to the Foundation as previously committed by Council.

-At the April 7, 2025 meeting Council is now moving forward with a lease for a daycare in the school. We are very excited to take the next steps in opening a daycare in our community! More information to come.

2025 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

The nomination period for the 2025 Municipal Election is officially open! If you're passionate about the Village of Andrew and want to shape its future, now is the time to run for Council!

Residents over the age of 18 can file nomination papers for the positions of Councillor or Mayor starting January 2, 2025, until noon on September 22, 2025. All candidates must schedule an appointment with the Returning Officer, CAO Kylie Rude, to submit their papers. Appointments are available during regular business hours, Monday through Friday.

Before accepting campaign contributions or incurring expenses, candidates must file their intent to run as per the Local Authorities Election Act.

The Village of Andrew will be holding a municipal election on Monday, October 20, 2025, where voters will elect one Mayor and four Councillors.

Nomination Period: Opens: January 1, 2025

Closes: September 22, 2025 at 12 noon.

WASTE DISPOSAL

When cleaning your yards and disposing of pet feces, please ensure you are using heavy duty garbage bags and double bagging as needed.

Please ensure any garbage you dispose of is less than 50lbs.

If bags rip open, our crew may need to leave them and we would ask that you kindly bag the items again ensuring the bags are not to heavy and put them out for pick up next week.

We appreciate everyone's assistance with the above matters.

Public Works does curbside Garbage Collection in the Village every Wednesday. Please note if you have mattresses, bedframes, microwaves, appliances and/or large items you will need to take these items directly to the dump.

GFL collects Recycling every Tuesday Items such as newspapers, paper, cardboard, plastics etc. are all items that can be placed in blue bags for pickup. For more info please see their website. gflenv.com. IF they miss a recycling pick up please call & report it to them: 780.444.8805

What can not be recycled:

- Window glass and mirrors
- Electronic waste (TVs & computers)
- Motor oil containers
- Ceramics or dishes
- Chemical containers
- Shredded paper

- Plastic bags
- Yard waste
- Styrofoam
- Food waste
- Scrap metal
- Monitors

**Please check with GFL for details of what's accepted and what isn't in your area. This general list does not apply everywhere, but it follows the most common practices, so always double check to avoid contamination.

2025 TAXES
