Residents over the age of 18 can file nomination papers for the positions of Councillor or Mayor starting January 2, 2025, until noon on September 22, 2025. All candidates must schedule an appointment with the Returning Officer, CAO Kylie Rude, to submit their papers. Appointments are available during regular business hours, Monday through Friday. Before accepting campaign contributions or incurring expenses, candidates must file their intent to run as per the Local Authorities Election Act.

ATCO POWER OUTAGE DAMAGE CLAIM PROCESS

Following the outage event that occurred within our Village over the eekend ATCO has provided ways that those affected can submit the damage claim.

1. Please note the importance that ATCO will require the following information when you reach out to track their claim accordingly

- Name: First and Last
- Contact Information: Phone Number and Email Address Site ID and Presmise (Address/Location) d
 - A description of items you want to claim Value: Dollar Amount
