COUNCIL MEETING UPDATE

At the May 28, 2025 meeting Council discussed budget priorities and tax rates. A number of areas were considered when determining which projects are funded each year and the best funding strategies. Rising costs are difficult on every small community. Council passed a 2025 final budget and corresponding tax bylaw. Tax notices will be mailed in June and are due July 31, 2025.

Council set a Special Council meeting for June 9, 2025 to select an engineer for the sewer line project & to address other priority items.

The Village has taken ownership of two houses due to tax forfeiture and is hoping to sell those in the near future with offers starting to be discussed. SIGN UP FOR e-BILLING

When you sign up for e-billing you can continue paying your utility bill or taxes as you normally do. e-Billing allows us to email you a copy of your bill rather than mailing it. You will conveniently and easily receive your bills in electronic document format.

Reminder to everyone who pays their utility bill or taxes via **e-transfer** the account number **MUST be included** in the Memo section in order to be applied to the proper account.

If you are making payments on behalf of someone else this is very important.

Including the account number in the memo section will ensure your payment is applied.

Residents over the age of 18 can file nomination papers for the positions of Councillor or Mayor now until noon on September 22, 2025. All candidates must schedule an appointment with the Returning Officer, CAO Kylie Rude, to submit their papers. Appointments are available during regular business hours, Monday through Friday.

Before accepting campaign contributions or incurring expenses, candidates must file their intent to run as per the Local Authorities Election Act.

The Village of Andrew will be holding a Municipal Election on **Monday, October 20, 2025**, where voters will elect one Mayor and four Councillors.

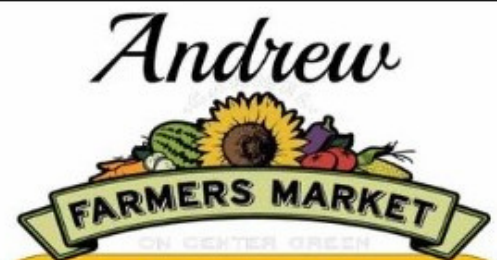
