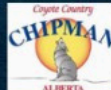

Residents over the age of 18 can file nomination papers for the positions of Councillor or Mayor now until noon on **September 22, 2025**. Candidate Packages can be picked up at the Village Office. All candidates must schedule an appointment with the Returning Officer, CAO Kylie Rude, to submit their papers. Appointments are available during regular business hours, Monday through Friday. Before accepting campaign contributions or incurring expenses, candidates must file their intent to run as per the Local Authorities Election Act.

The Village of Andrew will be holding a Municipal Election on **Monday, October 20, 2025**, where voters will elect one Mayor and four Councillors.

HOME & BUSINESS ADDRESS

Your address is a unique, assigned number that is useful to both you and others. It identifies where your property is in the Village, and this is especially for emergency services. Having your address clearly visible allows police, fire and ambulance to find your home quickly if ever needed.

It's your responsibility to make sure your address is visible. For high visibility you may consider using numbers that are made of reflective material and the colour of each number should contrast with the colour of the building. You only need to display your address at the front of your property. However, it is recommended to also posting your address at the back of your property (if it is accessible) to help in case of emergency.

Please take into consideration things that could affect your address display(i.e. obstruction from a large snowfall, vegetation, and poor visibility at night). Attach your address to the front of your building and have it face directly onto the road so anyone travelling in both directions can easily see the address. It is your responsibility to maintain and replace building address signage.

SIGN UP FOR e-BILLING

When you sign up for e-billing you can continue paying your utility bill or taxes as you normally do. e-Billing allows us to email you a copy of your bill rather than mailing it. You will conveniently and easily receive your bills in electronic document format.

The 2025 sidewalk improvement program began on July 8, 2025. Phase one of the program, which included addressing trip hazards has been completed in the following areas: 49 Avenue, 49 A Avenue and 51 Avenue

REMINDER:
ALL dogs MUST be registered with the Village Office every year.

Even if your dog is always kept indoors or in your yard they still need to be registered every year and have a dog tag.

If you have not registered your dog please do so immediately as the Bylaw Officer will be issuing fines for failure to comply in the amount of \$100.00.

The licensing fee for nutered dogs is \$20.00 and unaltered dogs is \$40.00.
